TOPIC -----

Although all Macintosh Performa 6300 computers include a 1.2 GB hard drive, there are two different part numbers for these drives in the Apple Price Pages. How do I know which one to order to replace a customer's drive?

DISCUSSION -----

The distinguishing factor between the two drives is the manufacturer. Be sure to order the replacement drive from the same manufacturer as the one you remove: If you remove a Conner drive from the computer, order the replacement Conner mechanism; if you remove a Quantum drive, order the replacement Quantum drive.
