MacTest Pro: PM 7500 & 8500 DIMM Slot Reported Chart (12/96)

TOPIC -----

I am using MacTest Pro on a Power Macintosh 7500 computer and it is reporting a bad DIMM in slot 6. However, the DIMM Slots are marked A1-A4 and B1-B4. How can I determine what slot 6 is?

DISCUSSION -----

The MacTest Pro memory tests are being revised to properly report the actual DIMM slots (A1-4, or B1-4) on the Power Macintosh 7500 and 8500 computers that the failure was detected in. This change will be in the next release of MacTest Pro.

Here is a chart of the DIMM slots and how MacTest Pro currently reports them.

Logic Board Slot	MacTest Pro Reported Slot
A1	1
A2	3
A3	5
A4	7
B1	2
B2	4
B3	6
B4	8
