

## Netware: Get Patch From Novell to Correct Directory Problem

TOPIC -----

Configuration:

- Workstation Compaq 386s with an AppleTalk card installed, running AppleShare PC DA 2.0.
- File server Compaq SystemPro with Netware 3.11 and the Apple NLMs. Apple modules loaded on server:

AppleTalk Stack/Router V3.03 (910920)

Netware for Mac V3.01 - AFP(20 user) (910727)

I can log on to the file server. However, when I enter the DOS DIR command, I get the following message:

VOLUME in Drive D: has no label Directory of D:\ Netware File Not Found.

No files or directories appear when I enter the DIR command, yet I have trustee rights to the directories. Even when I log on as SUPERVISOR nothing appears. I can change to a directory (for example, CD \SYSTEM) and Netware will recognize the command and point to that directory. I can also copy a file to and from a directory, but I can't see the files in the directory.

I'm able to log on to AppleShare and VAX Share and see the files. It just won't work with Novell.

DISCUSSION -----

Contact Novell for a Netware patch called "AFPFIX4.NLM". It corrects the problem.

To locate a vendor's address and phone numbers, use the vendor name as a

search string.
