Notions List Manager: Correcting Error -48210 (5/94)

TOPIC -----

Why do I get a -48210 error when I press any button after starting Notions List Manager?

DISCUSSION -----

Notions List Manager needs at least one template installed to run properly. Restarting Notions List Manager corrects this error. In version 1.0 of Notions List Manager, the absence of the template packages causes a piece of data to be missing. Restarting the application corrects this problem because the error generates a blank template. This blank template is used the next time the application is launched.

Unless you install one of the templates, you will see this error again following a hard reset, or if the storage card containing Notions List Manager is removed and then re-inserted into the Newton MessagePad.

The only way to permanently correct this error is to install one of the templates. Some of the templates, such as the "Built-in templates", use only a small amount of memory, so they can be used within almost any memory configuration.
