OracleCard 1.0: System 7 Compatibility

TOPIC -----

I recently upgraded to System 7 and I'm using MacTCP 1.1, ClearAccess 1.3, and OracleCard. I'm having compatibility problems now that I'm running System 7. Apparently ClearAccess 1.3 IS the correct version, and MacTCP IS the correct version also. They still aren't running correctly together.

Someone mentioned that I need SQLnet, but I can't seem to track this down. Also, someone said that I need the "January Patch" for MacTCP; I'm not sure if this is supposed to come from Apple or Oracle.

DISCUSSION -----

The current version of OracleCard 1.0 isn't System 7-compatible. It works for customers, but isn't officially supported. Also, you need SQLnet 1.5.1, which isn't released. Customers can call Oracle for a patch to the current version 1.5.

You need the "January Patch" for MacTCP only if you run it on a Macintosh Plus.
