PATHWORKS for Macintosh: Available Tools & Ethernet Support

TOPIC -----

I'm trying to get an account a terminal session to their DEC using MacTerminal 3.0. Their Macintoshes connect via AppleTalk and have a gateway to Ethernet via the Shiva FastPath product. How can they get their DECnet, 'ADSP'?

Is there a VT340 or a Tek 4105 Tool? A posted list of available tools would be helpful!

What 10BASE-T Ethernet cards does PATHWORKS support?

DISCUSSION -----

It is not clear if the account has PATHWORKS for Macintosh installed. If they do, all the components for DECnet software and ADSP should be there. They must configure the Shiva FastPath to support DECnet and install and configure DECnet on the Macintosh.

To our knowledge, there is no VT340 Tool or Tektronix 4105 Tool. Version 3.5 of VersaTerm-Pro supports the Tek4105 terminal emulation, but not in the forms of Tools.

We'll try to post tools developed by Apple and third-parties as they are available. We have not heard of too many tools besides the ones provided with the PATHWORKS package and a few others from third-parties. For example, Synergy is now offering a Telnet Tool, an FTP Tool, and a generic Driver Tool.

PATHWORKS for Macintosh should work with Apple's new Ethernet LC card and the 10BASE-T adapter. We don't know of any tests done with third-party cards. We have heard that another customer site did some preliminary testing with Asante and Cabletron products, and found that PATHWORKS had no problems with them.
