TOPIC -----

Can the Personal LaserWriter LS RAM be upgraded from 512K?

DISCUSSION -----

The Personal LaserWriter LS is shipped with 512K RAM and can be upgraded to 1MB. The upgrade instructions are in Volume 3 of the Technical Procedures for LaserWriters.

There is no Finished Goods RAM upgrade kit; however, the DRAMs are available from Apple Service (part number 333-0129) and third parties. Four DRAMs are required for the upgrade. When ordering from third-party vendors, be sure to specify 256Kx4, 100ns or faster DRAMs.

Note: The 1 MB memory upgrade does not improve printing performance.
