

## **PowerBook: Don't Use Terminator With Caere Typist Scanner**

TOPIC -----

Connecting the Typist by Caere Corp. locks up the SCSI bus on the PowerBook. The same scanner works with other Macintosh computers with System 7. We tried two terminators and several PowerBooks; other SCSI devices work with the PowerBooks.

DISCUSSION -----

We were able to scan successfully with the Typist by connecting it directly to the PowerBook without any terminators in the chain. The Typist requires at least 2MB of space, and you'll need to turn on virtual memory to use Microsoft Word. TeachText worked with virtual memory off. Copyright 1992 Apple Computer, Inc.
