## PATHWORKS: Volume Alias Doesn't Use VMS UAM Log-On Method

In PATHWORKS, using the VMS UAM log-on method, the password can be up to 31 characters. However, if you create an alias for the volume, then double-click on the alias to mount the volume later, VAXshare doesn't use the VMS UAM log-on method anymore, and allows only an 8-character password. This makes System 7 alias unusable for volumes with passwords longer than 8 characters.

DISCUSSION -----

Thanks for bringing this to our attention. We reproduced the problem and will report it to Digital. Digital has taken over all PATHWORKS development except for MacX, MacTCP, and DAL.
