Performa 600: Obtaining System Software

TOPIC -----

If I use the 5.25 internal expansion bay for a larger, non-apple, internal hard disk, or purchase a large capacity external SCSI hard disk, I need to install system software on that third-party drive. Since I don't receive system software disks with the Performa 600, must I purchase the System 7.1 package?

DISCUSSION -----

A Performa 600 customer doesn't need to purchase System 7.1. To install system software 7.1p on a new hard drive:

- 1) Perform an Apple Backup of your existing software to floppy disks.
- 2) Perform an Apple Restore to the new drive.

Apple Backup allows you to select either the System Folder or the entire hard drive for backing up.
