TOPIC -----

Will existing RAM cards work in the PowerBook 165c?

DISCUSSION -----

Because of the additional board attached to the processor card, some of the new third-party RAM cards may not work in the PowerBook 165c.

- The system uses the same 85ns RAM card as the PowerBook 180.
- The 100ns cards will work, but they will slow the system down by 10 %.
- The Apple 4MB card will not have a problem because it does not stray over the processor board.
- The 6MB, 8MB, and 10MB memory cards have problems trying to stay in the space allocated for a memory card, and these may have problems working in all systems. Check with the vendor
