

## **PowerBook: Modems and Black Listed Number (4/93)**

TOPIC -----

How can the "Black Listed" number be suppressed and/or controlled in a PowerBook 2400 modem? When using phone book software for dialing, a data session cannot be established.

DISCUSSION -----

You can disable the "Black Listed" feature by entering an "AT\*C" command (without quotes). The AT command prevents all/any number(s) from being "Black Listed".

Note: The "Black Listed" number refers to an attempt to dial a number which is not a data modem or fax. Subsequent attempts are "Black Listed" or denied because it is not a valid number. Copyright 1993, Apple Computer, Inc.
