TOPIC -----

I recently bought a Performa 450 and was told I would get a Performa Plus Display monitor included with it. However, I received a monitor with the label "Performa Display" on the back of it.

DISCUSSION -----

You did get a Performa Plus Display with your Performa 450, as promised. Both the Performa Display and Performa Plus Display come prelabeled on the back as "Performa Display." However, due to an error, about 48,000 Performa Plus Displays have product labels on the rear plastic that say "Performa Display." The "Plus" was left off in error. All the other information (box, user's manuals, and so on) correctly identifies the unit as a Performa Plus Display.

To truly identify the monitor, the marketing number that appears on the product label should be used:

Performa Display: M9101 . Performa Plus Display: M9102

The label problem has been corrected.
