TOPIC -----

Have there been any changes to the power supply used in the Power Macintosh and Quadra computers?

DISCUSSION -----

Apple will be rolling revised power supplies into some Power Macintosh and Quadra computers. Both power supplies are functionally equivalent and may look very similar.

For the Power Macintosh 8100 and Workgroup Server 8150:

661-1687 Power Supply (200W) - Original 661-0232 Power Supply (225W) - Revised

To identify the revised power supply, refer to the manufacturers label on the power supply. The label will have part number 614-0040 on the label as well as a marking as to the wattage of 225W. This power supply is backward compatible with all computers the original power supply is installed in.

Service Source and Price Pages will have them both listed when the revised one is available. Service Source CD and Module ID will note these are a like for like exchange.

For the Power Macintosh 7100 and Quadra 650:

We are also rolling in a revised power supply for these machines, the service part number will not change. As the part numbers are identical, there is no way to differentiate between them.
