What's wrong? DISCUSSION ------The MacTest Pro software will disable the RAM and Destructive logic board tests if AppleTalk is active. To enable the tests, follow this procedure: 1) Zap the PRAM in the PowerBook. 2) Boot from the internal hard drive or Disk Tools disk with extensions disabled. 3) Restart the PowerBook and boot from the appropriate MacTest Pro disk.
