

PC Exchange: System Folder Appears on DOS SCSI Drive (4/95)

TOPIC -----

In certain instances, a folder on an external SCSI drive formatted with DOS may appear with a System Folder icon. When it is opened, a new window appears with the exact contents of the previous window (that is a recursive folder). Booting with System 7.5 only extensions did not solve the problem. Turning off all extensions except PC Exchange had no effect on the problem.

DISCUSSION -----

This bug has been reported to Engineering and it is currently under investigation. Although the drive's directory appears corrupt on the Macintosh, it appears normal when the drive is reconnected to a DOS machine. Deleting this folder, that exists when the drive is used with PC Setup, is not recommended, as it may damage the directory.
