

Part Numbers: ...PA/A instead of ...LL/A (9/95)

TOPIC -----

I just purchased a Power Macintosh 7100/80 from my reseller and the part number is M3643PA/A. The price list shows the part number as M3643LL/A. Did I get the wrong product?

DISCUSSION -----

Most Apple hardware products marketed in the US end with "...LL/A". In Apple Pacific, most hardware products end with "...PA/A" for Pacific. If you have Japanese, Chinese or some other foreign Mac OS loaded on the hard drive straight from the box, you may have mistakenly received an international version of the product rather than domestic. You should check the hardware configuration as well as system and bundled software to make sure you have US versions.
