TOPIC -----

When should I use the grounding clip and fan that are included with some of the processor upgrade cards for the PCI-based Power Macintosh computers?

DISCUSSION -----

Currently the 132 MHz Processor Upgrade Card includes a grounding clip, and a fan, whereas the 120 MHz version does not. You only need to install the grounding clip if the 132 MHz Processor Upgrade Card is installed in a Power Macintosh 7500 or 7600 computer. The fan is needed only when installing the 132 MHz Processor Upgrade Card in a Power Macintosh 9500 computer.
