

Power Macintosh/Performa 5200: Which Revision Is It? (2/97)

TOPIC -----

Is there a quick and easy way to determine whether a Power Macintosh or Macintosh Performa 5200 series computer is a Revision A or a Revision B?

The Service Source CD refers to checking the speakers/housing, which is not always convenient.

DISCUSSION -----

Yes, there is another easier way to determine which revision the computer is. Turn the computer around, and look at the bottom of the case plastics. There should be a sticker/label there with one of four possible part numbers, as well as the manufacture date.

Revision A: Sticker contains a part number of 620-0635 or 620-0835.

Revision B: Sticker contains a part number of 620-0637 or 620-0837.

Once you have determined the revision of the case plastics, you know the revision of the entire system.
