

SuperMac Video Cards: Macintosh Quadra 700/900 Compatibility

TOPIC -----

There have been reports of some compatibility problems between the Macintosh Quadra series and several SuperMac Technology video cards.

SuperMac is telling customers that there is a battery problem and that the PRAM loses information for their video cards.

DISCUSSION -----

SuperMac Thunder/24 Cards

Revision G of the Thunder/24 card fixes the "no video at startup" problem. Thunder/24 cards require revision G or later with 1.161 ROMs for Macintosh Quadra compatibility.

Spectrum/24 PDQ+ Cards

Spectrum/24 PDQ+ cards should be revision A3 or later with 1.191 ROMs to ensure Macintosh Quadra compatibility.

Spectrum 8.24 PDQ Cards

Spectrum 8.24 PDQ cards require a ROM upgrade to fix a marginally serious problem (encountered only with the RasterOps timing settings). This ROM upgrade will be available mid- to end-February 1992.

Thunder/8 Cards

Thunder/8 cards require a hardware revision. These are being handled as special cases.
