TOPIC -----

When I try to launch the Startup stack on the Service Source CD, I get the error message, "Can't understand arguments of lock".

DISCUSSION -----

If you try to run the Service Source CD with a HyperCard version earlier than 2.1, you get this message. The Service Source CD requires HyperCard 2.1.

If you don't have the HyperCard 2.1 application, you can create it from the Service Source CD disk, using this procedure:

- 1) Open the "Disk Images" folder on the CD.
- 2) Double-click on the "HyperCard 2.1.dart" file.
- 3) When the decompression window appears, insert an 800K disk into the floppy drive and click "Start". The HyperCard 2.1 application and Home stack will be copied to the disk.
- 4) Choose "Quit" from the File menu when this operation is finished.
- 5) Trash the earlier version of the HyperCard application and Home stack from your hard drive.
- 6) Copy the HyperCard 2.1 application and Home stack from the floppy disk to your hard disk.
