

System 7: Upgrading System 6, Applications on Desktop Disappear

TOPIC -----

I've been using System 6 on my Macintosh and putting my applications on the Desktop. After I installed System 7 and rebuilt the Desktop, these applications disappeared. They appeared again in their correct place when I opened the hard disk icon. But now when I try to open a document created by any of these applications, I get an error message that says, "The application cannot be found." What's happening?

DISCUSSION -----

The fix is to move the applications to the hard disk window, then move it back to the Desktop. This seems to "force" the Finder to update the Desktop correctly. Copyright 1993, Apple Computer, Inc.
