StyleWriter II: Envelope Size and How to Change It (3/93)

TOPIC -----

The original StyleWriter driver printed number 10 size envelopes. The StyleWriter II driver instead prints C5 size envelopes, which are a different size. Why was this changed?

How can I print number 10 size envelopes with the StyleWriter II driver?

Also, can I use a PREC editor to modify the StyleWriter II driver? Can I cut and paste the old PREC from the original StyleWriter driver to the StyleWriter II driver?

DISCUSSION -----

After receiving feedback from customers, Apple UK Product Marketing suggested that the #10 envelope selection in the original StyleWriter driver be changed to C5 envelopes.

To print #10 envelopes with the StyleWriter II driver, you must modify the driver. The easiest and best way to do this is through ResEdit. You must modify the StyleWriter II PREC id=3 resource directly for the paper sizes you want. You must also change the paper name, and the paper height and width corresponding to the "button" you want changed. Note that they use the term button in the PREC 3 template even though it is a pop-up menu item.

The paper height and width values are the dimensions in inches x 120.

- For a #10 Envelope, the height is 495 and the width is 1140.
- For a DL envelope, the height is 520 and the width is 1040.
