TOPIC -----

Which Macintosh systems can use the SuperDrive (FDHD) dust shield? Why don't all Macintosh systems use the shield?

DISCUSSION -----

SuperDrive (FDHD) dust shields are installed, shipped, and tested in the following models:

- Macintosh SE and SE/30
- Macintosh IIX, IICX, IICI, IIFX, IISI, and IIVX
- Performa 600
- Centris 610 and 650
- Quadra 700, 900, and 950

In the systems where the dust shields are not normally installed:

- In some cases, they don't fit.
- In other cases where they fit (in most environments), they may provide only marginal improvement in dust protection.
