TOPIC -----

How do I get a single element out of the "System Update Disk v 3.0 Archive" on Disk 1 of System Update Disk v 3.0?

DISCUSSION -----

With Installer 4.0 archive files such as System Update Disk v 3.0 Archive, you have to run the Installer and go to Custom Install to extract specific pieces of the archive.

NOTE: With Installer 4.0, when you expand files from an archive, the creation date of the files are set to the creation date of the archive, and the modification date is set to the current time when you are installing. The version numbers of the individual files are correct.

So if you are used to checking creation and modification dates in addition to the version numbers, this may be confusing.

The Installer will be updated to avoid this problem.
