## System Update Disk v 3.0: Custom Remove Grayed Out (5/94)

### TOPIC -----

When I try to "custom remove" the System Update Disk v 3.0, the items are grayed out. Why can't I remove it?

### DISCUSSION -----

With Installer 4.0, whenever you write a script that uses the Custom install menu, you automatically get the Custom remove menu as well. System Update 3.0 has nothing that we want to be custom removed, and since the menu comes up by default, we have to grey out all the items. This is normal, expected behaviour.

We don't want to support any custom removes because:

- 1) We don't have any way to keep older versions of system resources (such as Standard file, serial drivers) to replace the newly removed items.
- 2) Most everything else the user can drag out of their System Folder, and again we don't have the disk space on the installer disks to keep all the older versions around.
