

System 7.5: Problem With Installer and Daystar Products (11/94)

TOPIC -----

We are seeing cases where older Daystar accelerators are having problems with the System 7.5 Installer. Is there any additional information available on this problem?

DISCUSSION -----

DayStar Digital has provided the following information:

- Connectix MODE 32 for 7.5 is required for users installing 7.5 on: Macintosh II, IIx, IIcx, and SE/30. It must be installed previous to installing System 7.5 or file corruption will occur.
- DayStar strongly recommends a "clean install" of System 7.5 versus an Easy Install on top of an existing system.
- 3) Using version 4.0.1 of the ROMs and version 2.2 of QuadControl control panel will provide the best results.
- 4) Daystar is aware of the following problems:
 - Virtual memory does not work.
 - The QuadControl control panel crashes in 24 bit mode.
 - Maxima 3.0 and CloseView cause problems in some machines.

DayStar Engineering is working on a fix to these problems which may take the form of a new QuadControl, ROM or both. No further information is available at this time.
