Workgroup Server 9150 Upgrade: No Top Cover Included (2/95)

TOPIC -----

What is included with the Workgroup Server 9150 upgrade? The packing list states that a new top cover is included but I didn't find one in the upgrade I did.

DISCUSSION -----

To upgrade a Quadra 900 or 950 computer to a Workgroup Server 9150, you must install the Workgroup Server 9150 main logic board upgrade. Please refer to the Service Source CD (January 1995 or later) for installation instructions.

The Workgroup Server 9150 Logic Board Upgrade bundle incorrectly lists a new top cover as part of the upgrade. This information will be corrected in the near future after review by product marketing.

The Workgroup Server 9150 Logic Board Upgrade contains the following:

- Workgroup Server 9150 main logic board
- System Software
- 8MB DRAM
- 512K Second-Level Cache SIMM
- Apple RAID 0/1 Software
- Macintosh On-Site Upgrade Service

NOTE: This upgrade is not for use with the Workgroup Server 95.

UPGRADE ISSUES

- Quadra 900/950 DRAM is not compatible with the Workgroup Server 9150 logic board.
- Power Macintosh memory must be expanded in pairs of like-density 72-pin SIMMs. Customers who purchase logic board upgrades and who have expanded their previous server's DRAM by using a single SIMM or variable density SIMMs must purchase additional memory if they wish to install their existing memory in a PowerPC-based server.
- Logic board upgrades must be installed by an Apple Authorized Service Provider

(AASP).
