Peter & Santa Claus CD: Memory Alerts (12/93)

TOPIC
1: When trying to run Peter & Santa Claus, why does an alert appear saying that there's not enough memory?
2: Why do I get an alert saying, "The application 'Peter and Santa Claus has unexpectedly quit (out of system memory)?"
DISCUSSION
 Answer to Question 1: Ensure that there is enough memory available by choosing "About This Macintosh" from the Apple Menu and examining your largest unused block. Peter & Santa Claus requires at least 2300K of memory to run. Remove any extensions or control panels that create a low memory situation in the background (such as background compression utilities). This will decrease the amount of memory used by your system software and allow more memory for your CD application. If using Virtual Memory, restart the CPU to ensure that memory is not fragmented. Close all windows in Finder. Quit any running applications. If you still do not have enough memory, you may want to consider purchasing more.
 Answer to Question 2: If you are running under System 6.0.7 MultiFinder and do not have over 5MB of memory available, you will receive this alert. Peter and Santa Claus will run properly on a 4MB CPU if you switch over to Finder instead of MultiFinder. Copyright 1993, Apple Computer, Inc
