Newton Connection Kit for Macintosh: Installing Packages (7/93)

TOPIC -----

This article explains how to install a package onto Newton using the Newton Connection Kit for Macintosh.

DISCUSSION -----

A package is a file that adds features to your Newton. They may be applications, fonts, forms, collections of information or other software.

To install a package:

- 1) Connect your Newton to the Macintosh that has the package on it.
- 2) On your Macintosh, double-click the Newton Connection icon to open it.
- 3) Click the Install Package button.
- 4) In the box that appears, choose the package you want to install, and click Open.
- 5) Open the Extras drawer on the Newton.
- 6) Tap the Connection button.
- 7) In the box that appears, choose serial or AppleTalk to reflect the mode of connection you used when linking the Newton and Macintosh.
- 8) Tap Connect.
