

Newton: How to Connect to a Printer (7/93)

TOPIC
This article describes what printers you can use with your Newton and how to connect your Newton to a printer.
DISCUSSION
You can connect several different types of printers to your Newton:
• Apple personal printers, including the StyleWriter/StyleWriter II, Personal LaserWriter LS and Personal LaserWriter 300.
• Apple network printers, including Postscript-compatible LaserWriter printers
• Non-Apple dot-matrix and ink-jet printers, when used with the Newton Print Pack.
To connect to an Apple personal printer, plug one end of the printer cable into the Newton's communication port and the other end into the printer.
To connect to an Apple network printer, plug one end of the network cable into the Newton's communication port and the other end into the printer.
To connect to a non-Apple printer, follow the directions in the Newton Print Pack.
