## Newton: How to Set and Change a Password (5/96)

TOPIC -----

This article discusses how to set and change a password on your Apple MessagePad.

DISCUSSION -----

You can protect the data on your Apple MessagePad by setting a password. When you set a password, you have the option of requiring the password each time your Apple MessagePad is powered on, or at certain intervals.

If you set a password and forget it, you will not be able to use your Newton again until you perform a hard reset.

Setting a Password with Newton 1.x OS

=====

Step 1

-----

Tap the Extras button at the bottom of the screen

Step 2

-----

Tap Prefs

Step 3

-----

Tap Personal in the Preferences Menu

Step 4

-----

Tap Set Password.

Step 5

-----

Write your password in the dialog box that appears.

If you use non-alphabetic characters, you will have to use the on-screen keyboard.

Step 6

-----

Tap Set to set your password or tap X to cancel.

Note:

You will be asked to enter your password every time you turn on your Apple MessagePad.

Setting a Password with Newton 2.x OS

=====

Step 1

-----

Tap the Extras button at the bottom of the screen.

Step 2

-----

Tap Prefs

Step 3

-----

Tap Security

Step 4

-----

Tap Set PIN

Step 5

-----

Tap the numbers on the keypad you want your PIN to be

Step 6

-----

Tap the ENT

A new keypad appears requesting you enter your PIN again.

Step 7

-----

Tap your PIN numbers on the keypad

Step 8

-----

Tap the ENT

New buttons appear in the Security slip

Step 9

-----

Tap the Ask for PIN button

A list appears with several choices

Step 10

-----

From the list, tap you choice when you want the PIN request to appear.

Changing a Password with Newton 1.x OS

=====

It is a good idea to change your password periodically.

Here is how to change your password:

Step 1

-----

Tap the Extras button

Step 2

-----

Tap Prefs

Step 3

-----

Tap Personal

Step 4

-----

Tap Set Password

You will see a dialog box which has blanks for your old and new password. Write your old password in the blank. To change your password, enter a new password in its blank. To eliminate your password, leave the new password blank empty.

Step 5

-----

Tap Set to set your password, or tap X to cancel.

Changing a Password with Newton 2.x OS

=====

Step 1

-----

Tap the Extras button at the bottom of the screen.

Step 2

-----

Tap Prefs

Step 3

-----

Tap Security

Step 4

-----

Tap Change PIN

Step 5

-----

Enter you old PIN on the keypad

Step 6

-----

Tap ENT

Step 7

-----

Enter you new PIN on the keypad

Step 8

-----

Tap ENT

A new keypad appears requesting you enter your PIN again.

Step 7

-----

Tap your PIN numbers on the keypad

Step 8

-----

Tap the ENT

Step 9

-----

Close the Security slip
