Newton: Using Time Zones (7/93)

TOPIC -----

What does the Time Zones function do and how do I use it?

DISCUSSION-----

The Time Zones function allows you to set your current time zone in your Newton MessagePad and to check the time zones around the world.

To tell Newton the time zone you are in:

- 1) Tap the Extras button at the bottom of the screen.
- 2) Tap "Time Zones."
- 3) Tap the circle between the up and down arrows at the bottom of Newton's screen. A list of cities appears.
- 4) Tap the nearest city to your own.
- 5) Tap the "I'm Here" button, and Newton will place the circle locator there, and list the time and date.

To determine the time in another city:

- 1) Tap the Extras button at the bottom of the screen.
- 2) Tap "Time Zones."
- 3) Tap the circle between the up and down arrows at the bottom of Newton's screen. A list of cities appears.
- 4) Tap the city you want to know about.
- 5) Newton will place the square locator there and list the city's name, time, and date. Just below the map, Newton displays the distance between your location and the city you chose.

You may tell Newton when you change your time zone while traveling by following the steps above, choosing your destination from Newton's list and tapping the "I'm Here" button.

Remember to change the time zone back when you return to your home time zone after your travels. If you do not change your time zone, but change the date and time instead, Newton's time zone settings for the rest of the globe will be off.
