Starcore Dyno Notepad: Note Size Limit (4/94)

TOPIC -----

Can I create files that are greater than 4k in the Starcore Newton application called Dyno NotePad?

DISCUSSION -----

Both the Newton MessagePad and Dyno Notepad limit the size of note of 4k. The Dyno Notepad limit is on the sizes of individual note items or "topics". Dyno Notepad allows more flexibility in individual notes, by allowing multiple 4k topics.

Each topic of a dynonote can be up to 4K in size. When it reaches that 4K limit, the segment's bar stops and its length cannot be extended (the bar is just like the bar in the todo section of the Datebook application). This happens even if it is the bottom-most segment (you will just have an empty screen below it).

Once you reach the 4k barrier, you can draw a line to create a new topic segment, and you can continue the note what you were writing. It looks like one long segment (the bar remains contiguous between the two segments) but has an extra triangle next to the bar indicating that it is physically two parts. So it flows well, even though it is physically two different segments.
