## How to Edit Modem.CCL From AppleLink

The AppleLink Modem.CCL file can be edited from within the AppleLink application.

- 1. Start up AppleLink but do NOT connect (select "Work Off-Line").
- 2. Ensure that you have selected to "Connect via Modem.CCL" under Setup.
- 3. While holding down both the Option and Command keys, press the letter "e" key.

This procedure opens a window displaying the contents of the current CCL file, and allows you to edit and re-save the file.

Commands sent to the serial port are preceded by the "Xmit" string, as seen in the third line of the listing below. Your modifications to the CCL file may be made either to the existing "Xmit" line or by adding a new "Xmit" with the set-up string. Changes are made in label 1 of the Modem.CCL.

-LABEL 1 --reset modem

Flush go to label #2 if we see 'OK'

MatchStr 1 2 OK

Xmit ATZ\13

Wait 200 wait for OK from modem - fall thru if timeout

IncTries timed out

IfTries 2 60 jump to label #60 if failed twice

HangUp else hang up phone

Jump 1 try again
