AppleLink: How To Prevent Losing Clipboard Data When Launching

Users have reported that after copying text from a MacWrite document and quitting MacWrite, launching AppleLink wiped out the clipboard's contents. The copied text was no longer there to paste. This happened under System version 6.0, AppleLink 4.0, and the Claris version of MacWrite. There was only one Clipboard file available.

There is a workaround for this:

1. Have both MacWrite (or other application) and AppleLink running at the same time under MultiFinder.
2. You should have no difficulty copying information to the clipboard, then switching to AppleLink and pasting that information into your AppleLink file.
