## AppleLink-to-Internet via BITNET

TOPIC -----

How come I can't reach Internet people through AppleLink and DASNET?

DISCUSSION -----

Apple no longer uses the third-party DASNET# connection between the Internet and AppleLink.

Instead, some great people within Apple have accomplished the routing in-house between AppleLink, BITNET, and the Internet. Therefore, the correct instructions are as follows:

Sending from AppleLink to Internet or BITNET:

In the "TO" or "CC" field, enter the Internet or BITNET address followed by @Internet#.

Example: TO: john@stanford.edu@Internet#

Sending from Internet or BITNET to AppleLink:

In the "TO" or "CC" field, enter the AppleLink address followed by @AppleLink.apple.com.

Example: TO: USERID@AppleLink.apple.com
