AppleCD 300: Connecting to a PC? (10/94)

TOPIC -----

Is it possible to connect an AppleCD 300 to a MS-DOS PC using a SCSI interface?
Are there any drivers available for a MS-DOS PC?

DISCUSSION -----

While it is technically possible to do this, it is not supported by Apple.

In order to use the AppleCD 300 with a PC, you need:

- The Transtor SCSI card and driver, which are reasonably compatible with the AppleCD 300.
- A utility called MSCDEX that comes with MS DOS 6.0.
- A compatible sound card. Unless you have a sound card, you will not have sound capabilities. Finding a compatible sound card requires testing and some "trial and error" to make it work.
