| Is it possible to connect an AppleCD 300 to a MS-DOS PC using a SCSI interface? Are there any drivers available for a MS-DOS PC?  |
| DISCUSSION  |
| While it is technically possible to do this, it is not supported by Apple.  |
| In order to use the AppleCD 300 with a PC, you need:  |
| • The Transtor SCSI card and driver, which are reasonably compatible with the AppleCD 300.  |
| • A utility called MSCDEX that comes with MS DOS 6.0.   |
| • A compatible sound card. Unless you have a sound card, you will not have sound capabilities. Finding a compatible sound card requires testing and some "trial and error" to make it work. |
