## AppleCD 300i: How to Install Macintosh CD-ROM Setup Software

TOPIC -----

I purchased a Macintosh with the optional AppleCD 300i CD-ROM drive. How can I tell if the CD-ROM software necessary to run that drive is installed?

If the software isn't installed, how do I install it?

DISCUSSION -----

To check for CD-ROM software, pull down the Apple menu and look for "CD Remote". If "CD Remote" appears in that pull-down menu, the CD-ROM software is installed.

If "CD Remote" isn't in the Apple menu, follow these step to install the software:

- 1) Insert the Macintosh CD-ROM Setup disk into your computer's floppy disk drive.
- 2) Open the Macintosh CD-ROM Setup disk icon.
- 3) Open the Installer icon. The Easy Install dialog box appears.
- 4) Click Install.
- 5) When the installation is complete, restart your Macintosh.
