DISCUSSION -----

Microsoft Mail Tech Support confirms there's a known problem with Microsoft Mail server version 3.1a and CD-ROM activity when running on the same Macintosh. If you're running an MS Mail server on a system with a CD-ROM drive, any CD-ROM activity will cause the MS Mail server to hang.

Microsoft has corrected the problem in MS Mail Server 3.1c and later. Please contact Microsoft directly regarding an upgrade for the MS Mail server.
