DISCUSSION
The monochrome monitors do not use dot pitch.
Dot pitch is a specification for the placement of the three (red, green and blue) dots that make up one color pixel. Since the monochrome image is made of only one dot, there is no need for a pitch specification since that one dot will be the entire pixel. Copyright 1991 Apple Computer, Inc.
