

Video Monitors: Why Some Screens Have Squared Corners

TOPIC -----

I'm using a Macintosh SE/30 to which I added an AppleColor High-Resolution RGB Monitor. I noticed something unusual about the monitor's display area: all corners, except the lower left, are rounded. The lower left has a squared (right-angle) corner. Is this a defect?

DISCUSSION -----

This is not a defect nor is it peculiar to the AppleColor High-Resolution RGB Monitor -- we have seen these squared corners on other Apple and thirdparty monitors. It's just cosmetic and is more likely to happen when multiple monitors are connected to the computer. Copyright 1992, Apple Computer, Inc.
