This article describes the Apple Adjustable Keyboard.

DISCUSSION -----

The Apple Adjustable Keyboard has a new ergonomic design that helps your wrists stay in a neutral position for comfort and typing ease. Its main feature is a "split" alphanumeric keyboard that lets you adjust the left- and right-hand sections up to a 30-degree angle to find the typing position that feels right for you.

The Apple Adjustable Keyboard also includes:

- Detachable palm rests to provide a flat surface to rest your hands when you're not typing.
- Volume up, volume down, mute, and record keys, valuable in multimedia applications.
- A separate extended keypad that includes function keys, special keys for document editing, a numeric keypad, and cursor-control keys
- Adjustable feet so you can change the slope of both the main keyboard and the extended keypad.
