Apple Scanner: Ofoto Upgrade for 32-Bit Addressing (12/93)

TOPIC -----

I have the original Apple Scanner, and I'm using the latest version of AppleScan, which I downloaded from AppleLink. This software doesn't seem to support 32-bit addressing. How can I use the Apple Scanner and 32-bit addressing under System 7?

DISCUSSION -----

The older versions of the Apple Scanner software do not support 32-bit addressing. To use your Apple Scanner and 32-bit addressing under System 7, you need to purchase Ofoto from LightSource, Inc., which is the software we include with our newer Apple OneScanners. This is especially important if you have a Centris 660AV, Quadra 660AV and Quadra 840AV, all which run only in 32-bit addressing mode.

Ofoto is not available as a separate product from Apple. However, there are two Ofoto upgrade kits available from LightSource: one version works only with the Apple Scanner, and the other version works with all scanners.
