## Apple Color Printer: Software Requirements and Installation

This article tells you what software comes with the Apple Color Printer, and gives you tips on how to properly install it.

DISCUSSION -----

### Installation

-----

The Apple Color Printer requires System software version 7.0 or later.

The Apple Color Printer's accessory kit contains five 800K disks, which hold the Installer, printer driver software, ColorSync, and TrueType fonts. The Installer places the driver, ColorSync, TrueType fonts, Chooser, Printer Share and the display profiles into the System Folder.

NOTE: Use the Chooser installed by the Apple Color Printer Installer.

An important piece of the Apple Color Printer software environment is a new Chooser that supports printer sharing. If you install System 7.1 or an earlier version of System 7 after installing Apple Color Printer software, it will overwrite the Apple Color Printer Chooser. It's important to reinstall the Apple Color Printer Chooser if this should occur.
