LaserWriter Driver 7.1.1 and 7.1.2: Differences

TOPIC -----

What are the differences between LaserWriter Drivers 7.1.1 and 7.1.2? When should a user upgrade?

DISCUSSION -----

The changes in LaserWriter Driver 7.1.2 are as follows:

- Support for the Fonts Folder within the System Folder of System 7.1.
- Workaround for a very rare bug in the LaserWriter IIg: printing TrueType fonts after they are downloaded to the printer's hard drive sometimes results in incorrect or no output.
- Fix for a very rare bug when printing to a Personal LaserWriter NTR with some TrueType fonts: the printer purges the current job and restarts.
- Support for fonts with foreign names.
- Enhanced printer memory allocation when printing with TrueType fonts.

Apple recommends upgrading to this driver if you are:

- Using System 7.1.
- Printing TrueType fonts to a LaserWriter IIg with a hard drive.
- Printing TrueType fonts to a Personal LaserWriter NTR.
- Using international system software.
