## LaserWriter IIf and IIg: Adding RAM to Improve Performance

TOPIC -----

For high-end printing, we needed 12MB on a LaserWriter IINTX. What's the equivalent RAM needed on the LaserWriter IIf or IIg to get the same performance as a 12MB LaserWriter IINTX?

DISCUSSION -----

We haven't done any testing to compare the LaserWriter IIf or LaserWriter IIg to the LaserWriter IINTX in this way. We suggest trying the stock LaserWriter IIg with the same documents and adding memory as necessary. Adding more memory will help performance. The maximum RAM that the LaserWriter IIf and LaserWriter IIg can have is 32MB.
