LaserWriter IIf/g: RAM and Legal Size Pages

TOPIC -----

What happens if I print a legal size page on a LaserWriter IIf with 2MB RAM? Is it cropped, or do I get an error message?

Why can't a 2MB LaserWriter IIf print a legal size page when the LaserWriter IINT can?

DISCUSSION -----

In this situation, the LaserWriter IIf generates no error message and clips the document to lettersmall (7.89 x 10.30 inches) dimensions.

The LaserWriter IIf and LaserWriter IIg use PostScript level 2. PostScript level 2 requires more memory than PostScript Level 1. A LaserWriter IIf needs 3MB of RAM to have the same page size capabilities as the LaserWriter IINT.
