DISCUSSION -----

Yes, the two PPD files on the LaserWriter II<sup>f</sup>/II<sup>g</sup> ROM Upgrade Disk are named in reverse:

- The PPD file for the LaserWriter II<sup>f</sup> is named "APLWII<sup>g</sup>2.PPD".
- The PPD file for the LaserWriter II<sup>g</sup> is named "APLWII<sup>f</sup>2.PPD".

You can rename the files appropriately. There are no other known problems with the PPD files.
